Intr. HB 2021R1981

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
designated §8-39-1, relating to governmental websites; requiring municipalities to
maintain websites with specific information available to the public at no charge; requiring
information to be updated; and requiring updated information be provided to the Office of
Technology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 39. MUNICIPAL WEBSITES.

§8-39-1. Accessible municipal records; required information.

- (a) Beginning on or before December 31, 2021, each municipality shall maintain a website
 or online social media account or page that provides the following information accessible to the
 public without charge:
- 4 (1) The title and name of each elected office holder;
- 5 (2) The contact information of each elected office holder, including office telephone 6 number, facsimile number, office location, office hours and mailing address;
- 7 (3) A secure electronic means of contacting each elected office holder;
- 8 (4) A copy of each municipal ordinance in effect;
- 9 (5) A copy of the approved meeting minutes; and
- 10 (6) A schedule of regular meeting days for each calendar year.
- 11 (b) Each municipality shall update the information required pursuant to this section within
- 12 30 days of the date the change occurs and provide the updated information to the Office of
- 13 Technology who shall update the information on the wv.gov website.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require municipalities to maintain websites with specific information available to the public at no charge.
