1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating

to authorizing the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to

fees for physical therapist and physical therapist assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### §64-9-1. Board of Physical Therapy.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 28, 2020, authorized under the authority of §30-20-6 of this code, modified by the Board of Physical Therapy to meet the

objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on

December 16, 2020, relating to the Board of Physical Therapy (fees for physical therapist and

5 physical therapist assistants, 16 CSR 04), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Physical Therapy to promulgate a legislative rule relating to fees for physical therapist and physical therapist assistants.
