- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §11-3-9a, relating to exempting from personal property taxation, vehicles of
- 3 certain volunteer firefighters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. ASSESSMENTS GENERALLY.

§11-3-9a. Exemption from personal property tax on vehicles owned by certain volunteer

firefighters.

- 1 <u>One vehicle owned and operated by a trained and active volunteer firefighter shall be</u>
- 2 <u>exempt from personal property taxation upon written verification submitted to the applicable</u>
- 3 county assessor by the volunteer firefighter's department chief that the firefighter has completed
- 4 required training and actively participates in the volunteer fire department's activities.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt from personal property taxation vehicles of active trained volunteer firefighters.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
