1 A BILL supplementing, amending and increasing an existing item of appropriation from the State  
2 Road Fund, to the Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, fund 9017, fiscal  
3 year 2021, organization 0803, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

4 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document,  
5 dated February 10, 2021, which included a statement of the State Road Fund setting forth  
6 therein the cash balances and investments as of July 1, 2020, and further included the estimate  
7 of revenues for the fiscal year 2021, less regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2021; and

8 WHEREAS, It appears from the Statement of the State Road Fund there now remains  
9 an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the  
10 fiscal year ending June 30, 2021; therefore

11 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

12 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, to fund 9017, fiscal  
13 year 2021, organization 0803, be supplemented and amended by increasing an existing item of  
14 appropriation as follows:
