Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### **ARTICLE 6. STATE BUILDINGS.**

# §5-7-18. Sharps containers available in government buildings and facilities open to the public.

1 All state-owned buildings and facilities where a public restroom is accessible to members

of the public shall have a commercially manufactured leak-proof, puncture resistant sharps

container. If more than one restroom is available to both men and women, only one container in

4 <u>each men and women's restroom is required, if the restroom is clearly marked and designated as</u>

5 the location for sharps disposal for the public in that building or facility.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require sharps containers available in all state buildings facilities where public restrooms are available.
