1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,

designated §5-10-14a, relating to legislative pensions; prohibiting the use of other state

employment to acquire credited time for legislative pensions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### ARTICLE 10. WEST VIRGINIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT.

### §5-10-14a. Credited service prohibited for legislative pension.

- 1 <u>Members of the West Virginia Legislature shall not be credited service towards their</u>
- 2 legislative pension for work performed as a state employee of the State of West Virginia or any
- 3 other state, including employment upon retirement of their legislative position or other leave from
- 4 the Legislature. The commission shall adopt rules regarding credited time for members of the
- 5 Legislature which credits only time earned as a member of the West Virginia Legislature.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the use of other state employment to acquire credited time for legislative pensions.
