1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
 2 to authorizing the Fire Marshal to promulgate a legislative rule relating to standards for the
 3 certification and continuing education municipal, county, and other public sector building
 4 code officials, building code inspectors, and plans examiners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND
 PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-6-1. Fire Marshal.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 13, 2020, authorized under the
 2 authority of §15A-10-5(a) of this code, relating to the Fire Marshal (standards for the certification
 3 and continuing education municipal, county, and other public sector building code officials,
 4 building code inspectors, and plans examiners, [103 CSR 06](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Fire Marshal to promulgate a legislative rule relating to standards for the certification and continuing education municipal, county, and other public sector building code officials, building code inspectors, and plans examiners.
