1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 et seq. of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating generally to authorizing certain agencies of the Department of Commerce to 2 3 promulgate legislative rules; authorizing the rules as filed, as modified, and as amended 4 by the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and as amended by the Legislature; 5 authorizing the Department of Commerce to promulgate a legislative rule relating to 6 tourism development districts; authorizing the Division of Labor to promulgate a legislative 7 rule relating to high pressure steam boiler and forced flow steam generator requirements; 8 authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training to promulgate a legislative 9 rule relating to rule governing the submission and approval of a comprehensive mine 10 safety program for coal mining operations in the State of West Virginia; authorizing the 11 Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Cabwaylingo 12 State Forest trail system two-year pilot program permitting ATV's and ORV's; authorizing 13 the Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to defining the 14 terms used in all hunting and trapping; authorizing the Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to deer hunting rule; authorizing the Division of 15 16 Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to special migratory game bird 17 hunting; and authorizing the Division of Natural Resources to promulgate a legislative rule 18 relating to special waterfowl hunting.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-10-1. Department of Commerce.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 25, 2020, authorized under the authority of §5B-1-9(p) of this code, modified by the Department of Commerce to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on

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4 December 10, 2020, relating to the Department of Commerce (tourism development districts, 145
5 CSR 16), is authorized.

#### §64-10-2. Division of Labor.

The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 24, 2020, authorized under the authority of §21-3-7 of this code, relating to the Division of Labor (high pressure steam boiler and forced flow steam generator requirements, 42 CSR 03), is authorized with the following amendments:

#### §64-10-3. Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training.

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The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 19, 2020, authorized under the authority of §22A-1-6 of this code, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety, and Training (rule governing the submission and approval of a comprehensive mine safety program for coal mining operations in the State of West Virginia, 56 CSR 08), is authorized.

#### §64-10-4. Division of Natural Resources.

(a) The legislative rule filed in the State Register on February 26, 2020, authorized under the
 authority of §20-3-3a of this code, relating to the Division of Natural Resources (Cabwaylingo
 State Forest trail system two-year pilot program permitting ATV's and ORV's, 58 CSR 36), is
 authorized.

12 50), is authorized with the following amendment:
