1 A BILL to amend and reenact §20-2-42i of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating  
2 to the Class LL nonresident fishing license; and providing it be issued for three consecutive  
3 days.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.**

**§20-2-42i. Class LL nonresident ~~one-day~~ three-day fishing license.**

1 A Class LL license is a nonresident fishing license and entitles the licensee to fish for all  
2 legal fish except trout and to take frogs in all counties of the state for three consecutive days on  
3 the calendar dates chosen by the buyer and which will be specified on the license, except as  
4 prohibited by rules of the director or Natural Resources Commission and except when additional  
5 licenses, stamps, or permits are required. To fish for trout, a Class LL licensee must purchase  
6 and carry a valid Class OO trout stamp. The fee for the license is ~~\$39~~. This is a base license and  
7 does not require the purchase of a prerequisite license to participate in the activities specified in  
8 this section, except as noted.
