1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,

designated §16-2Q-1, relating to banning medical abortions using RU-486.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### <u>ARTICLE 2Q. MEDICAL ABORTION PROHIBITION</u>

#### §16-2Q-1. Prohibition on Medical Abortion.

- 1 (a) For the purposes of this act: "RU-486" refers to the drug commonly referred to as
- 2 "Mifepristone," "Mifegyne", or "Mifeprex," first developed by the French pharmaceutical company
- 3 Roussel-Uclaf in April, 1980.

- 4 (b) The manufacture, sale or transfer, possession, or transportation of RU-486 or any
- 5 <u>substantially similar generic or non-generic abortifacient drug within, the importation thereof into,</u>
- 6 <u>or the exportation thereof from the state of West Virginia is hereby prohibited.</u>
- 7 (c) Violation of this statute is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$3,000
- 8 or confine in jail no more than six months, or both fined and confined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to ban medical abortions using RU-486.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
