- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- designated §20-5-23, relating to the development of an incentive plan for West Virginia
- 3 veterans which includes reductions and discounts in fees and charges at state parks.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5. PARKS AND RECREATION.

§20-5-23. Development of comprehensive incentive plan for West Virginia veterans.

- 1 (a) The director, in consultation with the Department of Tourism and the Department of
- 2 <u>Veterans' Assistance, shall develop a comprehensive plan for the development of, and support</u>
- 3 for, a program which encourages the use of state parks and forests by veterans of this state. The
- 4 plan may include, without being limited to, reduced or discounted rates on charges and fees for
- 5 <u>campground rental fees, lodging, and visitor passes.</u>
- 6 (b) For purposes of this section, "veteran" means any West Virginia resident who has
- 7 served as an active member of the armed forces of the United States, the National Guard, or a
- 8 reserve component as described in 38 U.S.C. 36 §101. Notwithstanding any provision in this code
- 9 to the contrary, a veteran must be honorably discharged or under honorable conditions as
- 10 <u>described in 38 U.S.C. §101.</u>
- 11 (c) No later than March 12, 2022, the director shall submit to the President of the Senate
- 12 <u>and the Speaker of the House of Delegates a written report detailing the program developed</u>
- 13 <u>pursuant to subsection (a) of this section.</u>
- 14 (d) The director shall promulgate rules, including emergency rules, if necessary, to the
- Legislature in accordance with §29A-3-1 *et seq.* of this code.
