A BILL to amend and reenact §7-14-17c of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
to clarifying the amount of deputy sheriff's annual salary increase.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

### ARTICLE 14. CIVIL SERVICE FOR DEPUTY SHERIFFS.

#### §7-14-17c. Salary increment.

- 3 (a) Every deputy sheriff with one year or more of service shall receive an annual salary
- 4 increase in the sum of \$5 per month for <u>multiplied by</u> each year month of service.
- 5 (b) Once a deputy sheriff has served for one year, he or she shall receive a salary increase
- 6 in the amount of \$5 multiplied by his or her months of service. In each subsequent year, on the
- 7 <u>anniversary of the deputy sheriff's date of hire, he or she shall receive a salary increase in the</u>
- 8 amount of \$5 per month for each month of service since the deputy's hire date.
- 9 (c) Any incremental salary increase in effect prior to the effective date of this section that
- 10 is more favorable to the deputy sheriffs entitled to such increase shall remain in full force and
- 11 effect to the exclusion of the provisions of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to clarify the annual salary increase amounts due to deputy sheriffs.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
