1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, 2 designated §18-2-25d, relating to permitting graduate athletes to participate in 3 interscholastic athletic events during the 2021-2022 school year; providing legislative 4 findings; defining "graduate athlete"; mandating the West Virginia State Board of 5 Education waive certain eligibility requirements; limiting scope of athlete's participation; 6 and permitting continued participation while attending an institution of higher learning. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: **ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION** §18-2-25d. Interscholastic Athletics Eligibility Waiver for Graduate Athletes 1 (a) The Legislature finds: 2 (1) Precautions taken to contain the COVID-19 pandemic have severely impacted 3 students' ability to engage in high school sports and to be eligible for college scholarship 4 opportunities through participation in high school sports; 5 (2) The opportunity to play high school sports empowers student athletes, provides 6 necessary life skills, and supports community engagement; and

- 7 (3) Enrollment in many high schools in the state has been steadily decreasing due to the
- 8 <u>COVID-19 pandemic.</u>
- 9 (b) For purposes of this section, "graduate athlete" means an individual who:
- 10 (1) Was enrolled as a 12th-grade student in a high school in this state during the 2020-
- 11 <u>2021 school year;</u>
- 12 (2) Graduated from the high school in 2021; and
- 13 (3) Was eligible to participate in an interscholastic sport at the high school level at a West
- 14 Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission member school during the 2020-2021 school
- 15 <u>year.</u>
- 16 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, or the rules of the West Virginia
- 17 <u>Secondary School Activities Commission, the commission shall consider a graduate athlete as</u>

- 18 eligible for participation in interscholastic athletic events and other extracurricular activities of
- 19 secondary schools for the 2021-2022 school year.
- 20 (d) The West Virginia State Board of Education shall waive the following eligibility
- 21 requirements for participation in interscholastic athletics at the high school level under the
- 22 commission's rules for graduate athletes for the 2021-2022 school year only:
- 23 (1) Enrollment and attendance at a West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission
- 24 member school;
- 25 (2) Academic progress requirements;
- 26 (3) Age restrictions; and
- 27 (4) Graduate eligibility restrictions.
- 28 (e) A graduate student may only participate in an interscholastic athletic program of the
- 29 high school from which the graduate athlete graduated.
- 30 (f) A graduate athlete may also be enrolled at an institution of higher education while
- 31 participating in an interscholastic athletic program under this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit graduate athletes to participate in interscholastic athletic events during the 2021-2022 school during to the COVID-19 pandemic.
