- 1 A BILL to repeal §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
2 all relating to repealing antiquated provisions relating to void gaming contracts, recovery
3 and loss of money in gaming, and recovery of gaming losses by bill in equity.

ARTICLE 9. GAMING CONTRACTS.

§55-9-1. Gaming contracts void.

- 1 [Repealed].

§55-9-2. Recovery of money or property lost in gaming.

- 1 [Repealed].

§55-9-3. Recovery of gaming losses by bill in equity; repayment discharges winner from punishment.

- 1 [Repealed].

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal §55-9-1, §55-9-2, and §55-9-3 of the Code of West Virginia to remove antiquated provisions of the code relating to gaming activities.
