1 A BILL to repeal §3-9-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to wagering or
2 betting on elections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Repeal of article regarding wagering or betting on elections; penalties.

1 That §3-9-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the section on wagering or betting on elections.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
