- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-3-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
- 3 relating to Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 16, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §22-5-4 of this code, relating to the Department of Environmental Protection
- 3 (Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources, 45 CSR 16), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources.
