- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the State
- 3 Building Code.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-6-1. Fire Commission.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §15A-11-11 of this code, modified by the Fire Commission to meet the objections of
- 3 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on January 7,
- 4 2022, relating to the Fire Commission (State Building Code, 87 CSR 04), is authorized with the
- 5 amendment set forth below:
- On page 5, paragraph 4.1.f.1, by striking out everything after the word "shall" and inserting
- 7 in lieu thereof: "conform to the 2009 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code."

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the State Building Code.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
