- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating
- 3 to Licensing Procedures for Osteopathic Physicians.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the 2 authority of §30-14-14 of this code, modified by the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to meet the 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on 4 September 24, 2021, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (Licensing Procedures for 5 Osteopathic Physicians, 24 CSR 01), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Licensing Procedures for Osteopathic Physicians.
