- 1 A BILL to repeal §61-8E-1, §61-8E-2, and §61-8E-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as
- amended, all relating to the repealing requirements to display video ratings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 8E. DISPLAY OF VIDEO RATINGS OR LACK THEREOF.

- §1. Repeal of article relating to Display of Video Ratings or Lack Thereof.
- 1 That §61-8E-1 through §61-8E-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended are
- 2 repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal requirements relating to the display of video ratings.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
