1 A BILL to repeal §17A-10-3C of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 removing the \$200 fee for electric vehicle registration and the \$100 fee for hybrid vehicle
3 registration.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. FEES FOR REGISTRATION, LICENSING, ETC.

§1. Repeal of additional registration fees for alternative fuel vehicles.

1 That §17A-10-3C of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, is repealed.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to repeal the section of the code that requires an additional fee for electric and hybrid vehicles.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
