### **House Bill 4719**

1 A BILL supplementing, amending, and increasing existing items of appropriation from the State  
 2 Road Fund to the Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles, fund 9007,  
 3 fiscal year 2022, organization 0802, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

4 WHEREAS, The Governor submitted the Executive Budget Document to the Legislature  
 5 on January 12, 2022, containing a statement of the State Road Fund, setting forth therein the  
 6 cash balance as of July 1, 2021, and further included the revised estimate of revenues for the  
 7 fiscal year 2022, less regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2022; and

8 WHEREAS, It appears from the Governor’s Statement of the State Road Fund, there now  
 9 remains an unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation  
 10 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022; therefore

11 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

12 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to fund 9007, fiscal  
 13 year 2022, organization 0802, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of  
 14 appropriation as follows:
