Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §16-35-4 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources
- 3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
- 4 Register on September 24, 2021, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources
- 5 (Childhood Lead Screening, 64 CSR 42), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Childhood Lead Screening.
