- 1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
- 2 to authorizing the Board of Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating
- 3 to chiropractic telehealth practice.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. Chiropractic Examiners.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 13, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-16-5 of this code, modified by the Chiropractic Examiners to meet the objections
- 3 of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on December
- 4 15, 2021, relating to the Chiropractic Examiners (Chiropractic Telehealth Practice, 4 CSR 09), is
- 5 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Chiropractic Examiners to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Chiropractic Telehealth Practice.
