Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARD TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-3-7 of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (Continuing Education for
- 3 Physicians and Podiatric Physicians, 11 CSR 06), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Continuing Education for Physicians and Podiatric Physicians.
