- 2 to authorizing the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate
- 3 a legislative rule relating to requirements for licensure and certification.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-38-9 of this code, modified by the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing And
- 3 Certification Board to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
- 4 refiled in the State Register on December 21, 2021, relating to the Real Estate Appraiser
- 5 Licensing And Certification Board (Requirements for Licensure and Certification, 190 CSR 02), is
- 6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Requirements for Licensure and Certification.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
