Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANOUS AGENCIES AND BOARD TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Registered Professional Nurses.

- 1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on May 10, 2021, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-7-15a of this code, relating to the Board of Registered Professional Nurses
- 3 (Limited Prescriptive Authority for Nurses in Advanced Practice, 19 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Professional Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Limited Prescriptive Authority for Nurses in Advanced Practice.
