FISCAL NOTE

- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
- 2 designated §11-13MM-1, §11-13MM-2, §11-13MM-3, and §11-13MM-4, relating to school
- 3 personnel, providing for a housing tax credit for teachers residing in West Virginia for five
- 4 years or greater.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 13MM. HOUSING CREDIT FOR TEACHERS.

§11-13MM-1. Legislative purpose.

1	The Legislature finds that the retention of experienced teachers employed within the state
2	promotes the general welfare and safety of the people of this state by enhancing the education of
3	our students and future leaders.
4	In order to promote the retention of experienced teachers employed within the state, and to
5	bestow favor for their selfless services rendered, there is hereby provided a tax credit for the
6	teachers who remain residing within West Virginia and employed as a teacher for five years or
7	greater.
	§11-13MM-2. Eligibility for tax credit; creation of the credit.
1	(a) There shall be allowed to every eligible taxpayer employed as a teacher in the State of
2	West Virginia, who has been employed as a teacher and resided in West Virginia for five years or
3	greater, and is currently residing and employed as a teacher therein for the full duration of the tax
4	year, a credit for housing expenses against the tax payable under §11-21-1 et seq. of this code.
5	The amount of this credit shall be \$2,000 per year.
6	(b) The provisions of this article shall be reasonably construed. The burden of proof is on
7	the person claiming the credit allowed by this article to establish by clear and convincing evidence
8	that the person is entitled to the amount of credit asserted for the taxable year.
	§11-13MM-3. Legislative Rules.
1	The State Tax Commissioner shall provide by appropriate rule or regulation for the
2	reporting, filing, and application of claims of the tax credit provided for in this article in a manner in

3 <u>conformity with the legislative purpose.</u>

§11-13MM-4. Effective Date.

1 This article shall be effective for the tax year beginning after December 1, 2022.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a housing tax credit for teachers employed and residing in West Virginia for five years or greater.
