- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
- 2 designated §6-7-9, relating to prohibiting payroll deductions to electioneering
- 3 organizations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 7. COMPENSATION, <u>DEDUCTIONS</u> AND ALLOWANCES.

§6-7-9. Certain deductions not allowed.

- 1 <u>No state, county, or municipal government entity, or state agency may process payroll</u>
- 2 <u>deductions from any employee's paycheck to be directed to an organization that is engaged in</u>
- 3 <u>electioneering.</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit payroll deductions to electioneering organizations.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
