- 1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article,
- 2 designated §5A-6D-1, §5A-6D-2, and §5A-6D-3, all relating to the creation of the "No
- 3 TikTok on Government Devices Act"; providing for a definition; and providing for enactment
- 4 of the article.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

## ARTICLE 6D. NO TIKTOK ON GOVERNMENT DEVICES ACT.

### §5A-6D-1. Short title.

This article may be cited as the No TikTok on Government Devices Act.

### §5A-6D-2. Definition.

- 1 The term "covered application" means the social networking service TikTok or any
- 2 <u>successor application or service developed or provided by ByteDance Limited or an entity owned</u>
- 3 <u>by ByteDance Limited.</u>

#### <u>§5A-6D-3.</u>

Enactment.

- 1 The West Virginia Office of Technology shall prohibit the covered application TikTok, as
- 2 defined in subsection (2) of this section, from all information technology. There shall be exceptions

3 for law enforcement activities, national security interests and activities, and security researchers;

- 4 and for any authorized use of a covered application under an exception, requirements for agencies
- 5 to develop and document risk mitigation actions for such use.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create the No TikTok on Government Devices Act.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
