1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-5-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
2 authorizing the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative  
3 rule relating to out-of-school-time child care center licensing requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2022, authorized under the  
2 authority of §49-2-121 of this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources  
3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State  
4 Register on October 14, 2022, relating to the Department of Health and Human Resources (out-  
5 of-school-time child care center licensing requirements, [78 CSR 21](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to out-of-school-time child care center licensing requirements.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
