1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to West Virginia State  
 3 Police professional standards investigations, employee rights, early identification system,  
 4 psychological assessment, and progressive discipline.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY. TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-6-1. State Police.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2022, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §15-2-25 of this code, modified by the State Police to meet the objections of the  
 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 14, 2022,  
 4 relating to the State Police (West Virginia State Police professional standards investigations,  
 5 employee rights, early identification system, psychological assessment, and progressive  
 6 discipline [81 CSR 10](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State Police to promulgate a legislative rule relating to West Virginia State Police professional standards investigations, employee rights, early identification system, psychological assessment, and progressive discipline.
