1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to administrative
 3 procedures for the Nonpublic Funding for Election Administration Fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR SECRETARY OF STATE TO PROMULGATE
 LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Secretary of State.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on August 1, 2022, authorized under the
 2 authority of §3-1A-9 of this code, modified by the Secretary of State to meet the objections of the
 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on November 10,
 4 2022, relating to the Secretary of State (administrative procedures for the Nonpublic Funding for
 5 Election Administration Fund, [153 CSR 54](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Secretary of State to promulgate a legislative rule relating to administrative procedures for the Nonpublic Funding for Election Administration Fund.
