A BILL to amend and reenact §6-7-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
providing a housing allowance of \$2,000 per month for designated state constitutional
officers to assist in residing in the seat of state government.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 7. COMPENSATION AND ALLOWANCES.

- 25 (3) The salary of the Secretary of State shall be \$2,000 per month, provided the housing
- 26 <u>allowance is used for providing housing in the seat of state government;</u>
- 27 (4) The salary of the Commissioner of Agriculture shall be \$2,000 per month, provided it is
- 28 <u>used for providing housing in the seat of state government; and</u>
- 29 (5) The salary of the State Treasurer shall be \$2,000 per month, provided it is used for
- 30 providing housing in the seat of state government.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a housing allowance of \$2,000 per month for designated state constitutional officers to assist in residing in the seat of state government.
