- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new article
 designated §16-5EE-1, relating to clarifying parent and legal guardian access to a minor
- 3 child's medical records.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 5EE. PARENT AND LEGAL GUARDIAN ACCESS TO MINOR CHILD'S MEDICAL RECORDS.

§16-5EE-1. Parent and Legal Guardian Access to Minor Child's Medical Records.

- 1 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, and absent a court order
- 2 pursuant to Chapter 48 of this code that prohibits parental access, no parent or legal guardian of
- 3 an unemancipated minor child shall be denied access to medical records of his or her minor child.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to clarify that neither a parent nor legal guardian of a minor child shall be denied access to the minor child's medical records.
