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A BILL supplementing and amending Chapter 11, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Session, 2022, known as the budget bill, as amended, in Title II, from the appropriations of public moneys out of the Treasury in the State Fund, General Revenue, to the Department of Homeland Security, West Virginia State Police, fund 0453, fiscal year 2023, organization 0612, by supplementing and amending the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 by adding new language; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to fund 0453, fiscal year 2023, organization 0612, be supplemented and amended to read as follows:
