1 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 2 designated §20-2-43, relating to permitting non-resident students enrolled at West Virginia
 3 colleges and universities to purchase their hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses at the
 4 residential rate.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-43. Nonresident students at West Virginia colleges and universities classification.

1 Students who are enrolled at West Virginia colleges and universities in this state, including
 2 community and technical colleges and universities, shall be permitted to purchase hunting, fishing,
 3 and trapping licenses at the residential rate provided in this article for the duration of their
 4 enrollment at that college or university. The director of the West Virginia Division of Natural
 5 Resources shall implement the provisions of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit non-resident students enrolled at West Virginia colleges and universities to purchase their hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses at the residential rate.
