- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-6-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Fire Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to volunteer
- 3 firefighters' training, equipment, and operating standards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-6-1. Fire Commission.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §15A-11-9 of this code, modified by the Fire Commission to meet the objections of the
- 3 Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on October 5, 2022,
- 4 relating to the Fire Commission (volunteer firefighters' training, equipment, and operating
- 5 standards, 87 CSR 08), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Homeland Security to promulgate a legislative rule relating to volunteer firefighters' training, equipment, and operating standards.
