- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-8-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- authorizing the Division of Motor Vehicles to promulgate a legislative rule relating to denial,
- suspension, revocation, disqualification, restriction, nonrenewal, cancellation,
- 4 administrative appeals, and reinstatement of driving privileges.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 8. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-8-1. Division of Motor Vehicles.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 30, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §17A-2-9 of this code, modified by the Division of Motor Vehicles to meet the
- 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
- 4 September 16, 2022, relating to the Division of Motor Vehicles (denial, suspension, revocation,
- 5 disqualification, restriction, nonrenewal, cancellation, administrative appeals, and reinstatement
- of driving privileges, 91 CSR 05), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of Motor Vehicles to promulgate a legislative rule relating to denial, suspension, revocation, disqualification, restriction, non-renewal, cancellation, administrative appeals, and reinstatement of driving privileges.
