- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensing of
- 3 physicians and podiatric physicians and disciplinary procedures for applicants, licensees,
- 4 and credential holders.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

# ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

#### §64-9-1. Board of Medicine.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2022, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §30-3-7(a) of this code, relating to the Board of Medicine (licensing of physicians and
- 3 podiatric physicians and disciplinary procedures for applicants, licensees, credential holders, 11
- 4 CSR 01A), is authorized.
