1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
2 authorizing the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
3 osteopathic physician assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS
AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 29, 2022, authorized under the
2 authority of §30-3E-3 of this code, relating to the Board of Osteopathic Medicine (osteopathic
3 physician assistants, [24 CSR 02](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Osteopathic Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to osteopathic physician assistants.
