1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
 3 limited prescriptive authority for nurses in advanced practice.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MISCELLANEOUS  
 AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. Board of Registered Nurses.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 26, 2022, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-7-15a of this code, modified by the Board of Registered Nurses to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 November 10, 2022, relating to the Board of Registered Nurses (limited prescriptive authority for  
 5 nurses in advanced practice, [19 CSR 08](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of Registered Nurses to promulgate a legislative rule relating to limited prescriptive authority for nurses in advanced practice.

This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and underscoring have been omitted.
