## Senate Bill 638

[Originating in the Committee on Education; reported

on February 21, 2023]

1 A BILL to amend and reenact §18A-4-10a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, 2 relating to requiring county boards of education to pay their employees, for the purpose of 3 reducing absenteeism, a bonus at the end of an employment term for each of up to 10 4 unused days of personal leave accumulated by the employee; making receipt of bonus 5 optional to employee; making number of days employee receives bonus for at the 6 discretion of the employee; stating amount of bonus; stating all employees are eligible for 7 the bonus; providing that days for which employee receives bonus are lost to the employee 8 and cannot be converted into extended insurance coverage or increased retirement 9 benefits; and prohibiting bonus from being counted as final average salary for the purpose 10 of calculating retirement.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### ARTICLE 4. SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER **BENEFITS**. §18A-4-10a. Bonus for unused days of personal leave.

1 County boards of education are authorized to shall pay to their employees, including both 2 professional and service employees, or to defined groups thereof for the purpose of reducing 3 absenteeism, a bonus at the end of an employment term for each of up to 10 unused day days of 4 personal leave accumulated by the employee, during that employment term subject to the 5 following:

6 (1) Receiving the bonus is optional to the employee;

7 (2) The number of days up to 10 an employee receives payment for is at the discretion of 8 the employee;

- 9 (3) The bonus per day shall be equal to the average daily rate of a substitute in that position 10 in that school district;
- 11 (4) All county board employees are eligible for this bonus regardless of when the 12

employees were hired; began participating in the plan, as that term is defined in §5-16-2 of this

13 code; or first became a member of the Teachers Retirement System, pursuant to §18-7A-1 et seq.

- 15 (5) Any days that an employee receives the bonus for, pursuant to this section, are lost to
- 16 the employee and shall be deducted from his or her total accumulated unused leave;
- 17 (6) Any days that an employee receives the bonus for, pursuant to this section, may not be
- 18 converted into extended insurance coverage or increased retirement benefits, pursuant to §5-16-
- 19 <u>13 of this code; and</u>
- 20 (7) This bonus may not be counted as part of the final average salary for the purpose of
- 21 <u>calculating retirement.</u>
