A BILL to amend and reenact §64-7-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
authorizing the West Virginia Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule
relating to bail bondsmen in criminal cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
