- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-10-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the application process for the West Virginia Innovative Mine Safety Technology
- 4 Tax Credit Act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-10-1. Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the
- 2 authority of §11-13BB-13 of this code, modified by the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training
- 3 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State
- 4 Register on September 15, 2023, relating to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training (rule
- 5 pertaining to the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training application process for the West
- 6 Virginia Innovative Mine Safety Technology Tax Credit Act, 56 CSR 14), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the application process for the West Virginia Innovative Mine Safety Technology Tax Credit Act.
