1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Dentistry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to  
 3 practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia Controlled Substances  
 4 Monitoring Program database.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Dentistry.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 25, 2023, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §60A-9-5a of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Dentistry to meet the  
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on  
 4 September 18, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Dentistry (practitioner requirements for  
 5 accessing the West Virginia Controlled Substances Monitoring Program database, [5 CSR 10](#)), is  
 6 authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Dentistry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to practitioner requirements for accessing the West Virginia Controlled Substances Monitoring Program database.
