1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to  
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians to promulgate a legislative rule  
 3 relating to continuing professional education requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO  
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

**§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on April 25, 2023, authorized under the  
 2 authority of §30-35-4 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians to  
 3 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State  
 4 Register on September 11, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians  
 5 (continuing professional education requirements, [31 CSR 05](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Licensed Dietitians to promulgate a legislative rule relating to continuing professional education requirements.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from a heading or the present law and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
