1 .A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 licensure, practice requirements, disciplinary and complaint procedures, continuing
 4 education, physician assistants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO

PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on July 27, 2023, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-3E-3 of this code, modified by the West Virginia Board of Medicine to meet the
 3 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the State Register on
 4 November 1, 2023, relating to the West Virginia Board of Medicine (licensure, practice
 5 requirements, disciplinary and complaint procedures, continuing education, physician assistants,
 6 [11 CSR 01B](#)), is authorized.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the West Virginia Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to licensure, practice requirements, disciplinary and complaint procedures, continuing education, physician assistants.
