1 A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
 3 permitting and disciplinary procedures: educational permits for graduate medical interns,
 4 residents and fellows.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO
 PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Medicine.

1 The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 21, 2022, authorized under the
 2 authority of §30-3-7 of this code, relating to the West Virginia Board of Medicine (permitting and
 3 disciplinary procedures: educational permits for graduate medical interns, residents and fellows,
 4 [11 CSR 12](#)), is authorized.
