- A BILL to amend and reenact §64-9-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to
- 2 authorizing the West Virginia Board of Medicine to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
- permitting and disciplinary procedures: educational permits for graduate medical interns,
- 4 residents and fellows.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS AND AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-9-1. West Virginia Board of Medicine.

- The legislative rule filed in the State Register on November 21, 2022, authorized under the
- authority of §30-3-7 of this code, relating to the West Virginia Board of Medicine (permitting and
- 3 disciplinary procedures: educational permits for graduate medical interns, residents and fellows,
- 4 11 CSR 12), is authorized.
