- A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section,
 designated §18-2-44, relating to requiring public high schools to have full-time athletic
 trainers.
 - Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

	ARTICLE	2.	STATE	-	BOARD	OF	ED	UCATION.
	<u>§18-2-44.</u>	Public	schools	to	have	full-time	athletic	trainers.
1	(a) County boards shall provide proper medical services to all high school student athletes							
2	attending the schools of their county and shall have the authority to take any other action							
3	necessary to protect student athletes from injury, infectious diseases, or any other health condition							
4	affecting participation in athletic and related activities.							
5	(b) Each county board shall employ full time a minimum of one licensed athletic trainer for							
6	each high school participating in organized sports, ROTC, and performing arts to provide							
7	healthcare for all student-athletes regardless of gender or activity. The county may opt to directly							
8	hire a full-time athletic trainer to be paid from their annual budget, moneys from levies or with							
9	COVID CARES ACT funds, or the county may contract with a healthcare facility or university to							
10	employ a full-time athletic trainer.							
11	(c) Any person employed as an athletic trainer must be a certified athletic trainer licensed							
12	by the West Virginia Board of Physical Therapy in accordance with §30-20A-2 of this code.							
13	(d) Specialized health procedures that require the skill, knowledge and judgement of a							
14	licensed health professional may be performed only by licensed athletic trainers, or another

- 22 (e) The licensed athletic trainer shall be responsible for compliance with all WVSSAC
- 23 policies and provisions of this code, including §18-2-25a of this code (concussions), §18-2-25c of
- 24 this code (AED) and §18-2-25b of this code (Emergency Action Plans for sports).

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to have full-time athletic trainers at public high schools in West Virginia.
